What is decentralization?

Centralized platforms like Facebook and Twitter currently have full power to control their users' information and can sell their data, including location and other personal information to the highest bidder. Decentralization technology allows the control of digital data to be transferred from companies to their users, thereby increasing privacy and control. By utilizing decentralized technology, MeWe can provide their users with greater control over their content and privacy. Users will get to make decisions on how the platform works. Each person would have their own social graph, allowing them to keep their online network regardless of the platform they use. Users could even monetarily benefit from the value of their personal data.

How does decentralization protect my privacy and keep me in control?

According to the nonprofit organization, Project Liberty, private companies have always controlled our social networks and related data like our social graph - the digital representation of our online experiences and actions. By maintaining control of this information, companies can sell it to advertisers, feed us content and information that keeps us addicted, and not allow us to move our content and friend connections across digital platforms. By having our information in centralized locations, we are also at more risk of having our information stolen should the companies get hacked. Decentralizing our social graphs and digital data protects our privacy and gains back control of our digital identity.

Why is MeWe giving users the option to move to a decentralized platform?
